# 2020 Spectator Guidance – Fall Sports – As of 9/14/2020 – Subject to change

The central message to our spectators who attend our events is this: <u>If you do not feel well – Do Not Attend.</u>

<u>Practice Social Distancing outside of your immediate family as much as possible. Mask up and support our athletes!</u>

MUSTANG FANS: It will take all of us to ensure a successful fall sports season. Protecting our students, staff and fans STARTS WITH YOU! Here is what we are doing to make gameday safer.

## General Guidance for all events at Davis County Schools:

- Practice Social Distancing outside of your immediate family members.
- Admission will be charged for all events. Activity passes or exact change is recommended.
- Seating capacity will be reduced at football and volleyball games (JH & HS).
- Pets are PROHIBTED at all school activities.
- As per Governor Reynolds new proclamation issued on August 27<sup>th</sup>, she strongly encourages all Iowans two or older to wear a mask or other face covering when in public settings, especially in circumstances when it is not possible to remain six feet away from others outside their household, unless it is unsafe to do so because of health or disability.

#### **Sport Specific Spectator Guidance – Football**

- Students who sit in the student section are encouraged to wear a mask.
- Signage is posted on every other bleacher row asking you not to sit in that row.
- Families may sit or stand together but should socially distance from others.
- Kids will be asked to sit/stand with their families and be supervised by parents.
- KIDS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE ON THE PRACTICE FIELD.
- Standing outside the fence, spaced out, is encouraged.
- Concessions will be available on Locust Street behind the press box.
- Restrooms will be located at the softball field and porta potties along Locust street.
- Press box is limited to essential game personnel only (scoreboard operator, timer, announcer, home and visitor coaches (2 max), & media.)
- All Varsity Football games will be Live Streamed on Ottumwa Radio Sports Facebook page.

### Sport Specific Spectator Guidance - Volleyball

- PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF OTHERS AROUND YOU.
- Masks are highly recommended to be worn by all in attendance and may be required at times.
- Students who sit in the student section are encouraged to wear a mask.
- The first two rows of bleachers behind the team bench will not be available.
- The first row will not be available for spectators.
- Families may sit together but should socially distance from others.
- Kids will be asked to sit with their families and be supervised by their parents.
- Concessions will be available.
- Restrooms will be open. 3-4 people at a time inside the restrooms.
- Home Varsity matches will be filmed on Facebook Live by the DC A-Club.
- Middle school matches will be split into two sites (7th grade @ MS, 8th grade @ MCC.)

#### Sports Specific Spectator Guidance - Cross Country

- Masks are highly recommended to be worn by all in attendance and may be required at times.
- Families may sit or stand together but should socially distance from others.
- Kids will be asked to sit/stand with their families and be supervised by their parents.
- Space yourself out along the trail.
- Concessions will be available.
- Porta Potties will be on site.
- There will not be a traditional awards ceremony.
