

NV Winter Sports Spectator Guidelines for 7-12 Activities

All guidelines are subject to change based on updates with local, state, and national guidance.

This guidance will take us through January 8th We will send out more guidance as it is available.

General

Please accept personal responsibility for following public health guidelines **If you are not feeling well, please stay home!**

Practice safe social distancing (limit groups to single households) Abide by posted signage

Per new guidance from the Governor's Office and IDPH, spectators will be limited at events this winter. If the guidance is changed, we will update our policies.

Each player, coach, cheerleader, or other performer in the contest will be allowed to have their entire household come to their specific game.

- A household includes those people who live/reside under the same roof as the player, coach, cheerleader, or other performer
- Participants with two households are allowed members from each of the two households
- Player, coach, cheerleader, or other performer may either allow their household members OR be granted two tickets to non-household members

Managers, camera personnel, and game workers will NOT be allowed to provide any tickets to spectators.

*This guidance is provided by the IHSAA and IGHSAU based on the Governor's office proclamation.

- Spectators will check in at the admission table. We ask that all households enter the facility as an entire household if at all possible. Visiting fans will also check in at the admission table and checks will be made next to the player's name when the members of the household arrive.
- Once spectators have checked in, they will gain admission by paying or using the appropriate pass.

Pride of Iowa Conference passes will NOT be accepted by any conference school this winter.

The gym will have to be cleared at the conclusion of each game.

-If your child is not participating/performing in the contest that is going on spectators will not be allowed to enter the gym.

Face coverings are REQUIRED for ALL spectators over the age of two.

The first row of the bleachers will be off limits.

An additional row behind team benches will also be off limits.

You MUST remain 6 feet away from other households in the bleachers.

Households that check in together should sit with each other and six feet away from others.

Please note that with limited spectators the gym will be quieter which means comments directed towards officials will be much easier to hear. Please refrain from making such comments.

Concessions

A limited concession stand may be available for home events.

Restrooms

Our normal restrooms will be open.

<u>Streaming</u>

Middle School events will not be livestreamed.

Varsity events will be live streamed via the NV YouTube Channel
